### **Grouped Local Stakeholder Consultation (LSC) for the certification of the project "Syntropic Agroforestry Coffee Project in Kericho County, Kenya" under the PoA "Global Syntropic Agroforestry Program"**

GrowGrounds ApS (GG) in conjunction with Agrisolutions Enterprises Limited (ASEL) would like to invite all interested stakeholders to the Local Stakeholder Consultation (LSC) for the project "Syntropic Agroforestry Coffee Project in Kericho County, Kenya". The project converts approximately 1,800 ha in total area of coffee plantations (monoculture or with a few trees) into agroforestry systems with different coffee farmers dispersed across Kericho County and the adjoining border areas of Kisumu County. following syntropic farming principles.
